

Community Grants: Funding Application Project Grants

Funding Goals

Burns Memorial Fund for Children was established by a bequest of the late Senator Patrick Burns to support low-income children and youth in Calgary. Through the Community Grants program, we works towards the following goals:

- Each child is ready for school, experiences success in school and graduates
- Each child is healthy, safe and has access to optimal health care
- Each child has the opportunity to participate in recreational activities that help them to discover their talents and develop their full potential

Eligibility

Applicants must be federally registered charitable organizations. Funded projects must align with at least one of the goals outlined above and must assist Calgary children under 21 years of age who encounter barriers due to lack of financial resources.

Grant Amounts and Activities

The maximum grant size for 2024 is \$15,000 per grant. The grants are intended to support time-limited projects, seed or start-up activities, capital costs, one-time program costs, or other similar endeavors. Grants are not multi-year and cannot be used to cover ongoing program or staff expenses.

Deadline and Application Process

Applications are due on May 1, yearly. Grant decisions are usually made within ten weeks of the application deadline.

- A description of the work done through the project, and progress made towards the anticipated outcomes, using the measurement approach outlined in the application.
- A financial accounting of the funds granted.

Eligibility for future support is dependent upon acceptance of your project's final report by BMF.
